

Roadway Resurfacing Programs

Various Municipalities

ACT Engineers has prepared roadway resurfacing and reconstruction plans for several municipalities in New Jersey. These projects have been performed with funding from the municipalities themselves or NJDOT Local Aid Grants.

A typical scope of work for these projects includes assessment of the condition of the existing roadway, curb and sidewalk; survey location of the roadway, sidewalk and other physical features within the public right-of-way; preparation of roadway resurfacing or reconstruction plans, specifications and bidding documents; review of bids and recommendation for award, conducting pre-construction meetings; construction observation; invoice review; and project close-out. When NJDOT Local Aid is involved additional services include application for grant, administration of SAGE, and project close-out with NJDOT.
